This man's nakedness brought about a curse on his son. Noah (Gen 9:22-25)

A woman touched the hem of Jesus garment, and was healed of this problem. Issue of blood (Mat 9:20)

This man was clothed in camel's hair. John the Baptist (Mark 1:6)

This man gave his son a richly ornamented robe. Israel (Gen 37:3)

Soldiers cast lots over this man's garment. Jesus (John 19:24)

This man left his garment behind, as he fled a seductive woman. Joseph (Gen 39:10,11,12)

This man sewed fig leaves together to cover himself. Adam (Gen 3:7)

This man 'borrowed' his brother's garment to try and impersonate him. Jacob (Gen 27:15)

The armies that follow the Faithful and True are clothed in this. White linen (Revelation 19:14)

In Revelation 12 a woman is clothed with this: The Sun (Revelation 12:1)

This man's garments couldn't compare to the lilies of the field. Solomon (Luke 12:27)

This child was wrapped in swaddling clothes at his birth: Jesus (Luke 2:7)

In the parable of the wedding, what happens to the man who shows up without a wedding garment? He is cast into outer darkness (Mat 22:13)

This man's servant lied in order to obtain two garments from a foreign dignitary. Elisha (2 Kings 5:22)

According to the law of Moses, a garment could not be made from the following: Both wool and linen (Leviticus 19:19)

This man coveted a garment and some gold, and was stoned for it in the valley of Achor. Achan (Joshua 7:20,21)

Jesus said that we should not put new cloth on an old garment, why? The tear is made worse (Mat 9:16)

This man offered 30 garments to anyone who could solve his riddle Samson (Judges 14:12)

God clothed this man with coats of skin. Adam (Genesis 3:21)

In Bible times, being clothed in this type of garment indicated sorrow, distress or humility. Sackcloth (1Chronicles 21:16, Gen 37:34, 1Kings 20:)
